## **IRS Announces No Change to the Health Savings Accounts (HSAs) Maximums for 2011 Revenue Procedure (Rev. Proc.) 2010-22**

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) announced the 2011 inflation adjusted amounts for health savings accounts (HSAs) in Revenue Procedure 2010-22: <http://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-drop/rp-10-22.pdf>.

Annual contribution limits for calendar year 2011 are unchanged from the 2010 amounts:

### **Annual Contribution Levels for HSAs.**

Maximum annual HSA contributions for self-only HDHP coverage is \$3,050.

Maximum annual HSA contributions for family HDHP coverage is \$6,150.

### **Amounts for Annual Out-of-pocket Spending Maximums on HSA-Compatible HDHPs.**

Self-only coverage is \$5,950. Family coverage is \$11,900.

### **Annual Minimum Deductible Amounts for HSA-Compatible HDHPs.**

Self-only is \$1,200. Family coverage is \$2,400

### **Catch-up contributions.**

Individuals age 55 or older additional contributions remain at \$1,000 for 2011 and subsequent years.

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
